

June 7, 2010 - Email Update

Full-Time AUNBT Members:

Bulletin #11, on May 5, noted that the membership vote was overwhelmingly in favour of a binding Conciliation Board and that there were only three remaining issues: "economic adjustment (including the comparison group), intellectual property (both ownership and payment), and instructors' ceilings."

Negotiations in May, in particular meetings with the Conciliation Board on May 12, 13, 25, and 26, have led to tentative agreements on ownership and payment for UNB Online courses as well as the Instructors' ceiling/Senior Instructors' floor correction. Agreement on economic adjustment has not been reached.

We have agreed to several more days of meetings with the Conciliation Board which will occur during the summer. The Conciliation Board chair will finalize these dates in the near future. If mediation is not successful, the Conciliation Board will subsequently prepare their decision.
